[REDACTED] filed this Business Economic Loss Claim under the Settlement Agreement. The Settlement Program awarded [REDACTED] \$76,783.10, pre-RTP. BP appeals. On appeal, BP seeks either a remand or submits a Final Proposal of \$53,712, pre-RTP. BP claims in its Initial Proposal that the Settlement Program ignored a matching issue presented by revenues in June, 2009. Claimant recorded \$131,879 in Commission Income that month. BP correctly notes this was almost 20% of revenues for the year. In [REDACTED] Reply, however,



█ notes the revenue was properly matched with the month because █ paid out \$186,369 in commission expenses, which was also 20% of the total commissions paid out for the year. This corroborates Claimant's view of the record. In reviewing the record, it appears that Claimant passes, as the Settlement Program found, all seven matching rules under Policy 495. Given this, █ Final Proposal is closest to the correct award in this "baseball" appeal.
