[REDACTED] filed this Business Economic Loss claim under the Settlement Agreement. The Settlement Program awarded \$108,310.67, pre-RTP. BP appeals. I remand to the Settlement Program to re-calculate the award and, if different, to permit each party to submit a new Final



Proposal.BP alleges numerous errors committed by the Settlement Program in the calculation of this claim. In response, the Claimant has defended the Settlement Program's rationalization of financial discrepancies but has also submitted additional evidence in support of the claim. A remand is therefore appropriate to determine whether the new information adduced by Claimant changes the proposed Award and whether BP's arguments on discrepancies are correct or false.
