This is a BEL claim filed by an Alabama physician. The Settlement Program awarded \$47,830.87 (pre 0.25 RTP). BP appeals asserting that the Claims Administrator improperly classified the pension expenses as fixed and also improperly classified other expenses as fixed.

After a thorough review of the record in this matter, it is clear that the Claims Administrator reviewed the pension expense issues as well as the other expenses BP questions. This Panelist does not find error in the Claims Administrator's analysis. Claimant's Final Proposal is the correct result here.
