Claimant filed this BEL Claim and was awarded \$55,965.61 (pre-0.25 RTP). BP appeals.

BP asserts that the Settlement Program (SP) failed to properly reconcile Claimant's bank deposits with his P&L's. In response to a Request for a Summary of Review, the SP responded:

Per Calculation Note 13, DWH Accountant noted that "the provided reconciliation and available source documentation supports monthly revenues. Revenues reconcile with the Claimant's tax return and are consistent relative to the Claimant's business."

Additionally, per Doc ID: [REDACTED], Claimant provides "Annual Income Summaries broken out by month and customer". These statements show a total of \$28,933.32 reported in revenue for November 2010, which is consistent with the Profit and Loss statements showing a total of \$28,933 in revenue in November 2010.

This Panelist after full review, is satisfied that the SP's handling of the claim was appropriate. BP's appeal fails.
