██████████ filed this Business Economic Loss claim under the Settlement Agreement. The Settlement program awarded Claimant \$45,253.72, pre-RTP. BP appeals. On appeal, BP raises numerous questions concerning the accuracy of the financial records supplied by Claimant in support of its claim. The most troubling of these is Doc. ██████████. More troubling is that Claimant's Final Proposal agrees that



the document does not support the award and further agrees that the effect is to reduce the award dramatically. Given that the record is suspect, that multiple questions exist, and that there is an actual calculation error, the claim is remanded to the Claims Administrator. I request that the claim be returned to me after remand.
