This is a BEL Claim filed by a [REDACTED] janitorial and pool supply company. The Settlement Program (SP) awarded Claimant the sum of \$1,436.29 (pre - 0.25 RTP). Claimant brings this appeal.

Claimant's Appeal Comments state:

"The Claims Administrator made an error in matching the revenues and expenses according to Policy 495".

Claimant's Memorandum states that the award should have been at least 10 times greater.

The SP submitted Claimant's financials to the tests of Policy 495 and one of the seven tests was triggered. Accordingly, the SP reviewed this matter at least 3 times and the consistent result was the Eligibility Amount set forth above. This Panelist finds nothing to indicate that the SP miscalculated this award. BP's Final Proposal is the appropriate result.
